CONDITIONAL SETTLEMENT – AUSTRALIAN SHAREHOLDER CLASS ACTION

Summary

- IMF announces the conditional settlement of the securities class action in relation to Forge Group Limited (Receivers and Managers Appointed) (Administrators Appointed) ("Forge proceedings"), brought against former directors and the former directors' insurers (collectively "Respondents") with anticipated revenue to IMF of approximately \$7.5 million.
- This investment is held on IMF's own balance sheet.

Conditional Settlement - Australian Class Action

IMF Bentham Limited (**IMF**) announces that the Forge proceedings have been settled (conditional on execution of the deed of settlement by all parties and Court approval of the terms of the deed of settlement) with no admissions as to liability. If the proposed deed of settlement is approved by the Court, then the proceedings against the respondents will be dismissed.

If the deed of settlement becomes unconditional, IMF currently expects to generate revenue of approximately \$7.5 million, including reimbursement of project costs. This investment is part of IMF's on-balance sheet portfolio.
