

RELEASE TO AUSTRALIAN SECURITIES EXCHANGE MONDAY, 7 AUGUST 2017 CONDITIONAL SETTLEMENT - US CASE 36

Summary

- IMF announces the conditional settlement of US Case 36 funded in the United States
- IMF's income from the settlement is expected to be approximately \$2.9M
- This is the first case completion in IMF's global portfolio for FY18

Conditional Settlement - US Case 36

IMF Bentham Limited (ASX: **IMF**) announces the conditional settlement of a case funded in the United States by IMF's wholly owned subsidiary, Bentham Capital LLC (**Bentham USA**). This is matter number US36 referred to in our announcement of 10 March 2016 and is held as part of the Bentham USA portfolio outside of the investment vehicle.

The terms of the settlement agreement are confidential and the agreement is subject to Court approval.

IMF expects to recognise income of approximately \$2.9M from this investment and profit after capitalised overheads (but before tax) of approximately \$1.7M.

This outcome represents a return on invested capital (ROIC) for IMF from this investment of 2x and an IRR of approximately 91%.

IMF will provide further information in relation to this case once the settlement becomes unconditional or it ceases to have effect.
