### ANZ BANK FEES CASE – HIGH COURT SPECIAL LEAVE APPLICATION

1. The Board of Directors of IMF Bentham Limited (“IMF”) refers to its announcement of 8 April 2015 in relation to the Federal Court appeal decision in *Paciocco v ANZ Banking Group Limited* (“ANZ”).
2. IMF will fund an application by the Representative seeking special leave from the High Court to appeal the findings of the Federal Court in respect of credit card late fees only. The Representative was previously successful before the trial judge in respect of credit card late fees in the Federal Court. The Special Leave application has been filed today.
3. The ANZ Class Action is the first of a series of actions against major bank and credit card companies in Australia in respect of exception fees. One of the matters has been the subject of settlement discussions and the other matters have been stayed pending the final outcome in the ANZ case.
